

Below is a screen shot of what our Student Health Services at UC San Diego uses for our students regarding sex and gender.



And this is what it looks like in the patient chart:

Sex: Male (*Identity:Transmale/FTM; at birth:Female)

As you can see, there is lots of good information and ways of thinking about gender and sex that has been incorporated into the electronic record, which then shows up clearly and accurately in the chart.

Given the information, and with practice with the front-line staff and the medical providers, the data is used to assist our transgender students in not being mis-gendered, as well as receive appropriate and culturally competent care from the moment they are called back from the reception area to the examination rooms, through all levels of staff at the Student Health Services.
